



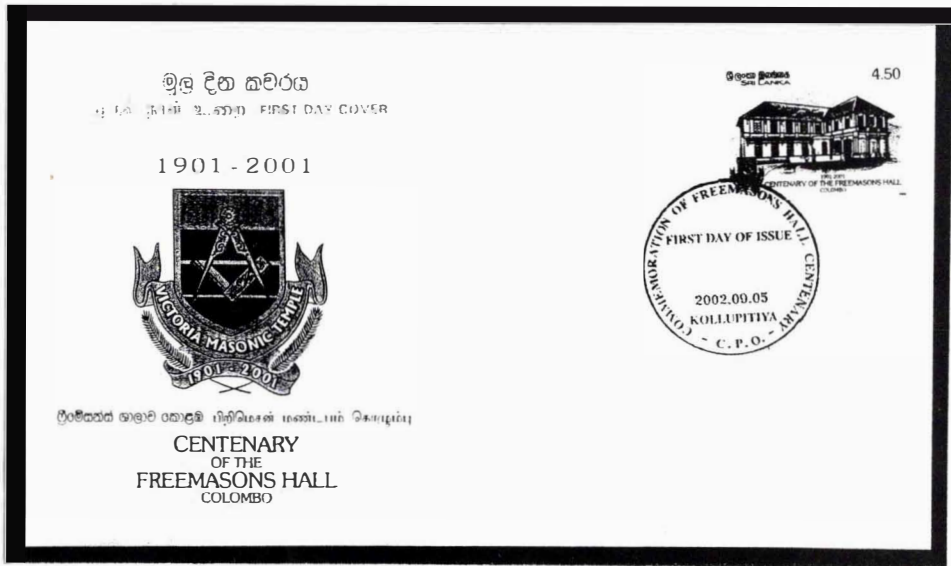

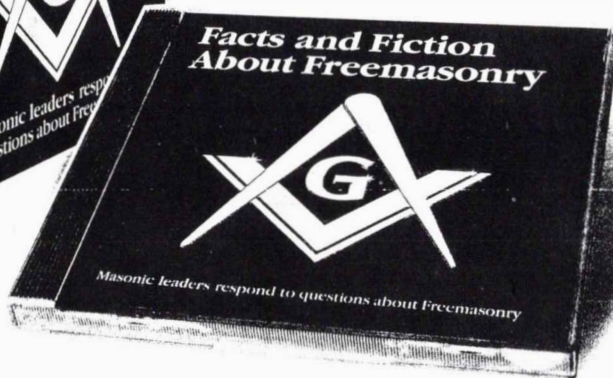
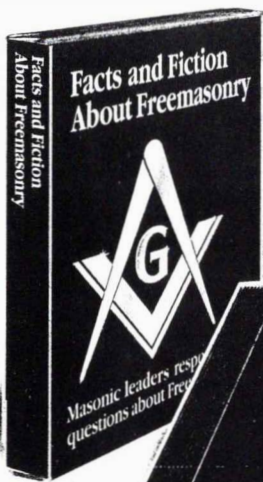

Why should I collect stamps based on the topic appearing on each stamp?

Because you are the best person to assemble a topical collection on a subject that you, yourself, find to be of interest. You do not have to cover all the little blocks in a preprinted stamp album until only those stamps, which you cannot afford, are still blank. YOU are the one to choose which stamps fit and which don't. At the same time that you are having fun in identifying and then finding the stamps that you want, you are getting more versed, or educated, in your subject. FUN and EDUCATION are the two main ingredients of collecting stamps by topic.

Why Join the ATA?

The ATA is the best source of information, education, fellowship and authority in the topical stamp collecting field. It is the world's largest specialist collecting organization. By joining the ATA, you will have access to some of our 140 handbooks, written by other collectors, so that you can more easily locate the stamps that are pertinent to your interest. This is the largest single source of books on topical stamp collecting available anywhere. Where handbooks do not cover your topic, or end a few years back, the ATA allows members only, to obtain any of over 400 checklists that are assembled by collectors. Past articles on your subject, that have appeared in earlier issues of our journal, *Topical Time*, can also be obtained from the ATA central office. Plans are being made for the books for 2003 and 2004, yet copyrite laws have again changed so we will be hunting for pre-1900 books for the most part. If you have suggestions as to books you would like to see reprinted please send them in.

The deadline for DUES for 2003 is April 1. Collection by that date allows us to pay the pre-printing cost and to do any research necessary for the 2003 book to be produced. Early submission would be appreciated. Postage rates in the United States increased once again, but the cost to ship a book overseas is now \$5 or more depending on the country. For the Club to operate we need approximately 1500 members. During this last year we lost over 200 members to death and 50 to resignations. The majority of our members are over 60. Therefore we are asking each of you to try to sign up a new member. We will reward the new member by sending him a bonus book from our past offerings. Please help us out.

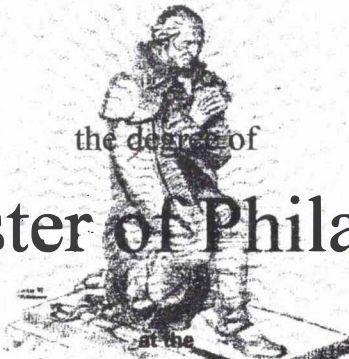

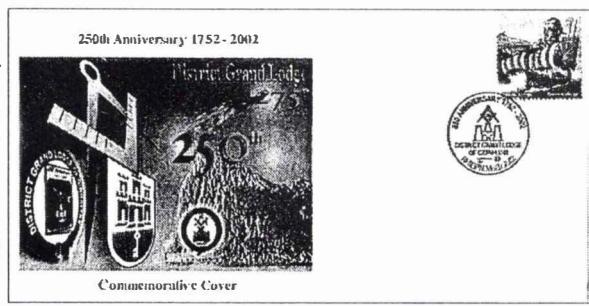
